Final Statement of Evaluation:

This is a neat little gun for being over 100 years old. The unique trigger safety is similar to the new Glocks. Looking up the history of this firearm was very interesting (see attached links for more information). Unfortunately the condition is poor, other wise it could be worth allot more. We disassembled and cleaned the firearm and found it not to be safe to fire (**Do Not Fire this Gun**). Many collectors prefer not to have antique guns restored, so you might contact someone who specializes in Iver Johnson firearms for more information.
