This is a good .22 cal rifle for being over 50 years. Unfortunately there is not a big demand for JC Higgins rifles at this time. The firearm does need a little work on the barrel due to rust. Also, there are some knicks on the stock that could be refinish. We fired three rounds out of the gun to check how it functioned which it did jam. The estimated cost to fix the barrel (cold blue), stock, and action work is **\$105**
